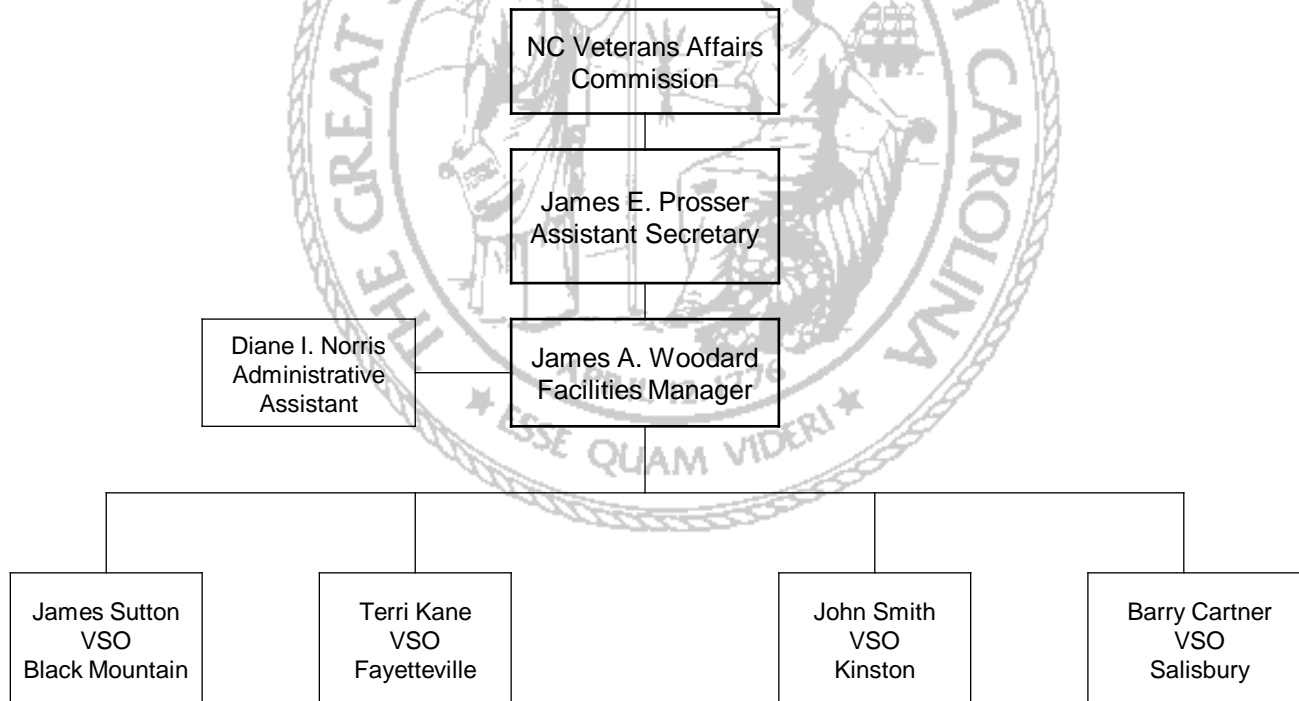

NC State Veterans Homes Program

- Skilled Nursing Care
- NC State Veterans Homes receive no State funding through appropriations.
- The North Carolina State Veterans Homes are owned by the State of North Carolina (North Carolina Department of Military and Veterans Affairs) and managed by a private entity, United Veterans Services of North Carolina, Inc., a subsidiary of UHS-Pruitt Corporation.

NC State Veterans Homes Program

- Management Contract is for a 5-year period. Renewal in 2019, with 5 1-year renewals.
- NC State Veterans Homes Program pays for all expenses.
- Management Contractor is paid a percentage of net revenue for services.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, Veteran must:

1. Have served on active duty for other than training purposes.
2. Be discharged under honorable conditions (DD-214).
3. Be a resident of North Carolina twenty-four (24) months prior to date of application.
4. Be referred by a licensed physician.
5. Be disabled by reason of age, disease, or other reasons determined through a physical exam. The medical staff will review the medical information provided to see if our facility can meet the need of the Veteran.

NC State Veterans Homes Program

- Non-Veterans may occupy no more than 25% of the total beds in a State Veterans Home. Eligible non-Veterans are as follows:
 1. Spouse
 2. Widow or widower whose spouse, if living, would be an eligible Veteran.
 3. Gold Star Parents, mother or father of a Veteran who died an honorable death while in active service to the United States during time of war or emergency.

3. Daily Cost of Care - \$107.00 per day

5. First Admission – November 2004
6. Female Admissions limited – 2 Semi-Private rooms share one bathroom
7. Every room has a television.
